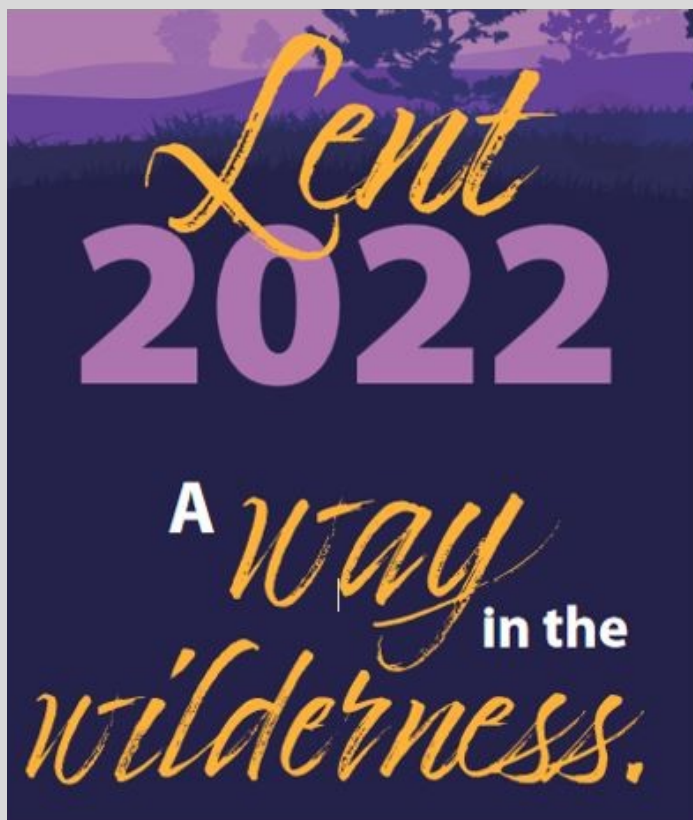

Lent is upon us!

I love this season of refocus and intentional spiritual discipline; somehow Lent manages to change my life every year. A long Lenten time ago, I began to pray every night before bed as a spiritual practice. This practice of evening prayer didn't stop when Lent was over, and because of it, I have continued to pray every night before bed. My life, as you can imagine, has forever changed because of my connection with God.

Other practices over the years, like not watching TV for all of Lent so I could focus on God and be intentional about how I utilized my free time, have also drastically improved my life. I enjoyed not having to listen to the bombardment of advertisements, and years later this inspired me to get rid of my television. I'll still intentionally seek out a movie on the computer every now and again, but this one Lenten Spiritual Discipline has freed me from unconsciously sitting through one show to the next.

Lenten disciplines like these have continually freed me by helping me refocus on what is important in life. This season is also a reminder that our lives are limited, and what we do now matters. Taking time to see how God is calling is something we can do at all times of the year.

I want to invite you to join us on Wednesdays, for Bible Study, Dinner, and Worship. Making this time commitment does take some discipline, but I do believe that it will change your life. We will be doing a Bible Study called "A Way in the Wilderness" that invites us to study, pray, reflect, and give. I will be praying for you as you respond to your call. Whether you respond to your call through the love of God or the love of neighbor, know that you aren't alone in this desert. We're here for you, and God is with you!

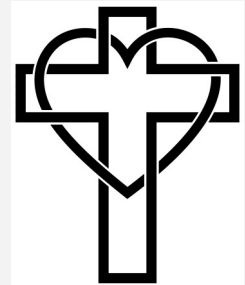

WELCA NEWS



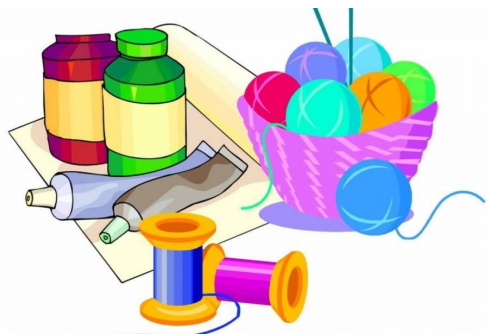
