#### President's Message

Perhaps you've noticed some of the physical improvements recently made at the church. The parking lots have been restriped, the driveway access to the ramp in front of the church has been completed, and new flooring has been installed in the pastor's office, the secretary's office, and the copier/file room. A new ice machine has been installed and is operable and (10) fire extinguishers have been inspected and (1) replaced.

A counterweight for the eternal flame in the chancel area has been ordered. Installation of the counterweight will allow the eternal flame to be pulled down to a height of 4 feet so the candle can be replaced without the use of a ladder. Fencing, posts, and gates have been made available for a pet containment area at the parsonage.

The playground has been secured for safety reasons until an equipment upgrade can be developed and implemented.

Since more handicapped spaces were created in the lower parking lot, questions have been asked if a handicapped placard or license plate will be required to park in those spaces. The answer is no! If anyone feels the need to use one of the handicapped spaces, it is available. No questions will be asked; it is a personal decision.
