A message from Pastor Fred...

Spring is on the Horizon!

March 20th is the official day of the spring equinox. The emergence of green may not be so abrupt, as we will gradually witness nature put forth new life in its own time.

In the Kingdom of God coming to reality on earth, I am noticing it arriving in its own time as well. Do you see it coming through in our community? Where do you see it emerging in our church? The Holy Spirit is very active in our world and our lives, but sometimes it takes focus to notice.

We have just entered into Lent in our liturgical calendar. There are a lot of concepts about what Lent is and what we should do during Lent, but boiled down it is simply this: Lent is about our relationship with Jesus. In this there is a lot to think about: Our Life, Jesus' Life; Our Death, Jesus' Death; Our Freedom, Jesus' Freedom. Our Relationships, Jesus' Relationships; Our Ministry, Jesus' Ministry.

To think about all of these concepts, focus is required. There are many distractions in our present time, but even when things were going crazy around Jesus, he still made intentional time to pray. We're going to follow in his footsteps by making intentional time to focus on our relationship with Jesus by coming together for Lenten Bible Study and Worship on Wednesdays. Our Bible Study will focus on transitioning "From Judgment to Hope," a work by Walter Brueggemann who is one of the most influential scholars in regard to the writings of the prophets. Our Lenten Worship will honor what we have learned in Bible Study and help us reflect on what Jesus is calling us into, as his grace changes us forever from lives of judgment into lives of hope in the everlasting Kingdom.

Please join us. The world tries to drag us all in with its drama, but the news will be just as tumultuous whether we watch it or not. In the upcoming Wednesdays in Lent, we are setting apart a time that is intentionally for living into God's holiness. Having this worshiping community is such a gift, and it's grounded in eternal reality. There is a peace beyond expression that comes along with dwelling in our faith, our trusting relationship with Christ. These weeks of Lenten Bible Study and Worship are available for you as Christ draws your life into his likeness. Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 3:

¹⁶when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. ¹⁷Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. ¹⁸And all of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord, the Spirit.

Out of this time of intentional focus, there will be growth. Verdant vibrance will spring forth in our proclamation of the good news of Jesus, and what a gift to the world we will be as we shine Christ's much needed light into this world to help it grow!
