Christ is risen! The joy that fills us in Christ's resurrection springs us forth into sharing his love into the world.

This spring we have a lot of growth to be excited about. Our confirmands have been hard at work studying scriptures and engaging with each other and the world around them in what they've learned. They are already shining Christ's light in this world, and they will affirm their baptism on May 28th!

They have learned that there are 2 sacraments with each consisting of 3 elements. Can you recall what they are? (Ask a confirmand if you need a refresher!) The first sacrament has already been mentioned. The second sacrament is something our 5th graders are going to receive for the first time on June 4th!

While they were eating, Jesus took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, 'Take, eat; this is my body.' Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he gave it to them, saying, 'Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. 
