President's Message

In the July edition of *The Journal*, the President's Message reported that Church Council had approved the formation of a Capital Fund Committee for the purpose of structuring a campaign to raise capital. It was also written that it was the intention to begin the campaign in September 2023 and conclude the drive by year end.

After two meetings with the committee, your president has come to the conclusion that the timeline written in *The Journal* was, at best, too ambitious, and at worst, totally unrealistic. This poor judgment is regretted and our apology is offered for the inaccurate information. An explanation will be presented on Rally Day Sunday to include details on how and when the campaign will proceed.

The committee will participate in six Zoom meetings with direction being offered by individuals with fundraising knowledge and experience. The campaign will be discussed from a broad-brushed perception at the Coffee & Conversation gatherings on September 17 and 24. The plan is to roll out the details of the fundraising campaign at the January Congregational Meeting and run it through Easter Sunday, March 31.
